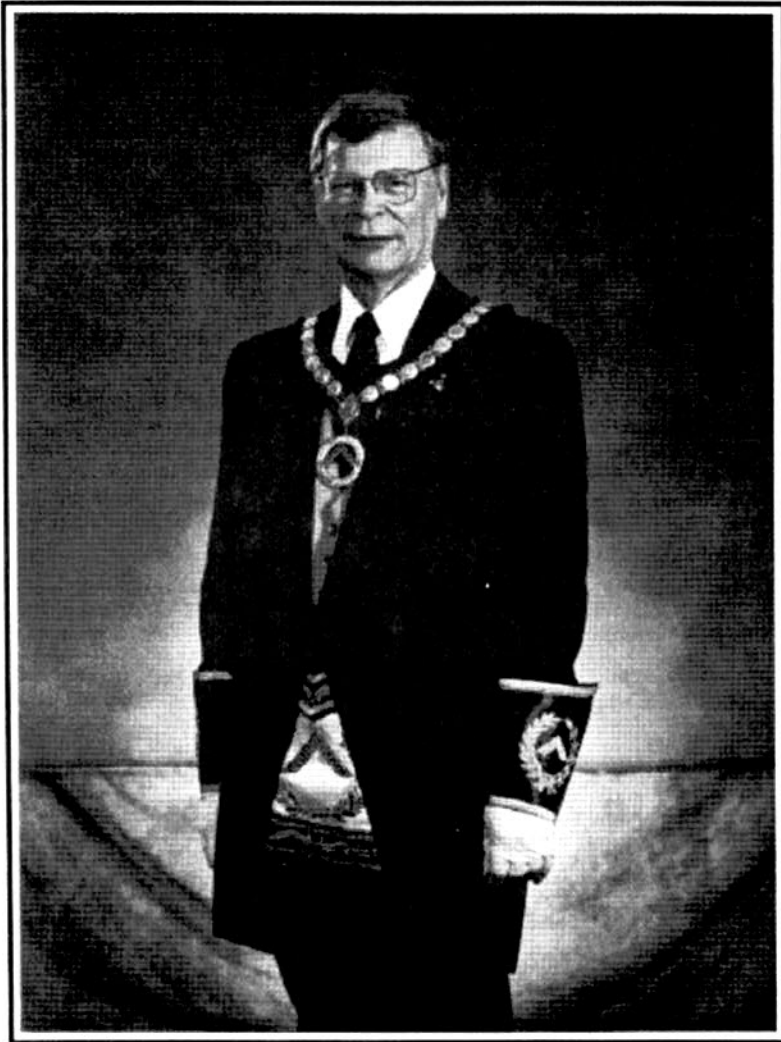

BIOGRAPHY

Deputy Grand Master

Brother Trosin was born in Tonawanda, NY, where he received his early education. After high school, he attended Syracuse University, graduating in 1961 with a degree in business administration. His business career was focused on the data processing industry. He is retired from Bell Aerospace Textron. At the time of his retirement, he was Manager of Information System Services.

Brother Trosin married in 1964, and he and Barbara have two married daughters, Rhonda and Heather, and one grandchild, Miranda.

Brother Trosin is a member of Salem United Church of Christ in Tonawanda, and has served as a Deacon, and on various committees.

In Freemasonry, Brother Trosin has an impressive resume of service, which will be only briefly highlighted here.

Although he was master of his lodge in 1981, Brother Trosin's early Masonic activity focused on several concordant organizations. He served as Grand Commander of Knight Templar in 1987, and Grand High Priest of Royal Arch Masons in 1993. His work in the Scottish Rite and Freemasonry, in general, was rewarded by his coroneting as a 33rd Mason, in 1992. He has served the Scottish Rite as Deputy's Representative for the Valleys of Buffalo and Lockport from 1997-2002.

Brother Trosin is also an active member of several honorary and related organizations including the Red Cross of Constantine, KYCH, and AMD.

Although Brother Trosin maintains a diverse portfolio of Masonic activity to this day, over the last decade he has focused much of energy on Grand Lodge. He was the Grand Representative of the Grand Lodge of Hawaii, F&AM from 1992-1994, and has been the Grand Representative of the Grand Lodge of Tennessee since 1996. Over the past 9 years he has served as Junior Grand Deacon, Senior Grand Deacon, Deputy Grand Marshal, and Grand Marshal, as well as, on many committees.

Brother Trosin's Masonic career thus far has provided him with a solid foundation to meet the challenges and opportunities facing Freemasonry today. He looks forward working with the Brothers of New York in his new role.
