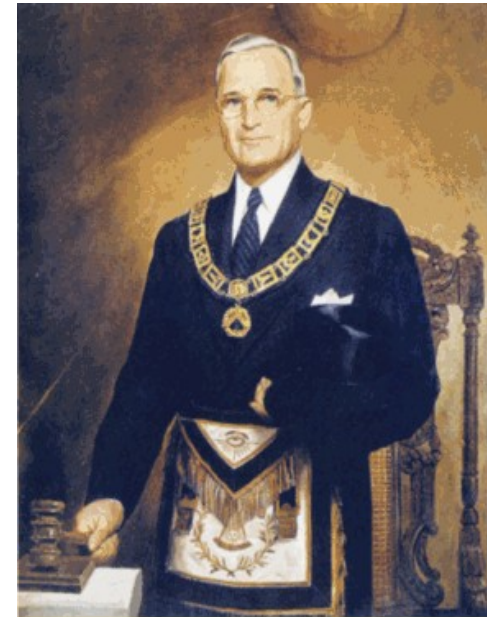

Born in the United Kingdom, and educated and professionally trained in England, Japan and America, Brother Robinson is a retired international commercial and investment banker and CEO, who was Initiated, Passed and Raised on March 29, 2003 during the tenure of M.·W.· Grand Master Carl J. Fitje. Since then he has approached Masonry with the same level of intensity and commitment as that demonstrated in his 40 plus year professional banking career spanning three continents.

He is a member and officer of seven (7) Lodges in three (3) Manhattan Districts (1st, 4th, & 8th) including Master of *James W. Husted – Fiat Lux Lodge No. 1068* (2009 to date) and Founding Member and Past Master (2006 - 2009) of *Lux Æterna Lodge No. 1184* and Secretary of *St. John's Lodge No. 1, A.Y.M* (2009 to date).

He has served as President of the *Eighth Masonic District Association of Manhattan* [2008-2010] and for the preceding three (3) years as Secretary of the District Association.

For the past four years has acted as Facilitator for the *MDC* and *RTTE Programs* in support of the two successive Grand Directors of Ceremonies of the Eighth Manhattan District.
