## BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION

W.:TREVOR STEWART

BA, M.Ed., M.Litt.

Brother Stewart is a retired college lecturer who was educated in England at Birmingham, Sheffield, Durham and Newcastle Universities. His research specialized in English 18<sup>th</sup> century literature. More recently, he has focused on the lives and cooperative work of a small coterie of gentlemen freemasons who lived in the south of County Durham [in the northeast of England] in the mid-18<sup>th</sup> century.

He has given lectures in Belgian, French, German and Scottish Lodges as well as many English Lodges and Royal Arch Chapters. He is a Past Master of Thornhill Lodge No. 3216, The Vale of Derwent Lecture Lodge No. 9051, Quatuor Coronati Lodge No. 2076 and a Member of Lodge 'Sir Robert Moray' No. 1641, in Edinburgh, Scotland, and an Honorary Member of St. John's Lodge No. 1, A.Y.M. (GLNY). He is also a PZ of the Thornhill Royal Arch Chapter. He has published several papers in the transactions of the Quatuor Coronati Lodge, the premier Lodge of Research. He has held office in all of the Orders which grace the English Masonic landscape, is a Life Member of various Scottish Orders and has been honored with Grand Rank in the Rectified Rite in Belgium and with the 30° in the AASR in Germany. He is active in several more esoteric Orders in the UK and abroad.

As a Lay Member of the Durham Diocesan Synod [Church of England], he is active in the administration of that diocese.
